Cost

The Registration fee (which includes room and board) from Sunday afternoon until Friday afternoon is **\$700.00** per student. This cost is based on shared accommodations. Registration fees are to be prepaid and cheques must accompany the enclosed forms.

There **are a limited** number of single accommodations available at a cost of **\$950.00**.
