TERMS OF REFERENCE

A. ELIGIBILITY

1. Parent, Guardian or Spouse of Applicant, or the Applicant her/himself must be a member in good standing of a CUPE Local affiliated to CUPE B.C. at the time of application.
2. Applicant must have completed Grade 12 in the current or previous calendar year.
3. Applicant must be entering first year of a recognized post-secondary institution in B.C. (including schools of Barbering/hairdressing; Nursing). A copy of the acceptance letter from the admitting institution must be supplied to the Scholarship Committee.
4. Applicant must complete an Application Form as supplied by the scholarship Committee, supported by copies of the Senior Secondary Statement and letter(s) of reference from school principal or counsellor.

B. DISTRIBUTION

1. Amount and number of scholarships shall be determined by the Scholarship Committee, based on the amount of interest available from the Memorial Trust Fund.
2. Scholarship Award(s) shall be determined by the Scholarship Committee based on Academic Achievement.
3. At least one scholarship will be awarded to a student enrolling in a community college or vocational institute.
