## **Indigenous Cleansing Ceremonies**

Dates: Thursday to Saturday, April 25 - 27, 2024

Time: 7:00am to 8:30am

Location: Cardero Park entrance (see map below)

Indigenous cleansing ceremonies will take place each morning of Convention. All delegates and guests are welcome to join at any point from 7:00am onwards, and you do not have to stay for the full duration of the ceremony. No prior knowledge nor experience are needed.

**Allergen alert:** Several traditions will be used throughout the ceremonies, which may include smudging and brushing with cedar. Smudging involves the burning of sweetgrass, sage, and/or cedar. Sage and cedar smudges produce a very strong aroma, but the smoke is minimal and lasts a very short time. Sweetgrass has a very mild aroma and produces less smoke.
